211 SLO HOTLINE also serves as a communications hub during a disaster, to connect people to services they need and to deliver essential information.

- Suicide

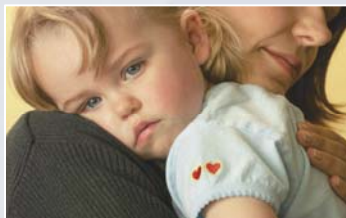

New 211 dialing for SLO County

In November 2007, Hotline joined the network of call centers offering 211 service to over 85% of all Californians and 75% of the U.S.

This easy to remember three-digit number for access to all health and human services is **available now** by landlines throughout San Luis Obispo County, and by cellular service by mid-2008.

In a disaster, 211 networks can link together statewide, or nationally if necessary, to help coordinate services and information so 911 operators are available for critical emergencies.
